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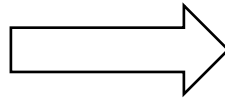

Strategy – Grouping

1. Kerry bought some identical notebooks and files from the bookshop.  
Kerry bought twice as many notebooks as the files.  
He paid a total of \$ 18.00 for the items. How many files did he buy?

1 Notebook : \$ 1.50

1 File : \$ 3.00

2. Some adults and children went to a school concert. There were 3 times as many children as adults. The total amount collected from the tickets was \$ 24.  
How many adults went to the charity concert?

1 Adult Ticket : \$ 2.40

1 Children Ticket : \$ 1.20

3. Mrs Lim baked some chicken pies and apple pies to sell at a charity fair.  
She baked 4 times as many chicken pies as apple pies.  
She sold all her pies and collected \$ 30. How many apple pies did she bake?

1 Chicken Pie : \$ 0.50

1 Apple Pie: \$ 1.00

Trending Problem Sums

1. The total mass of an empty box and 5 similar metal balls was 2.6kg.

The total mass of the same empty box and 3 similar metal balls was 2.34 kg.

- a. What was the mass of 1 metal ball?
- b. What was the mass of the empty box?

2. Mrs Lim baked 300 fruit tarts.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of them were pineapple tarts,  $\frac{2}{5}$  of them were strawberry tarts and the remaining were mango tarts.
- a. How many mango tarts did she bake?
  - b. Mrs Lim sold the pinepapple and strawberry tarts at 5 for \$9. How much would Mrs Lim collect from her sale of all the pinepapple and strawberry tarts?

3. Sarah gives some erasers equally to her friends. If she gives 6 erasers to each friend, she will need another 4 erasers. If she gives 5 erasers to each friend, she will have 3 erasers left.

4. Kelly has twice as much money as Hannah. Penny has \$ 350 more than Kelly. The three girls have \$ 1125 altogether.
  - a. How much money does Kelly have?
  - b. How much money must Penny transfer to Hannah and Penny so that all three girls have equal amount of money in the end?
