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Strategy 1: Internal Transfer

 Holly kept 280 sweets in 2 containers X and Y. After 25% of the sweets in Container X was transferred to Container Y, there were 20 more sweets in Container X than Container Y. How many sweets were there in Container X at first?

 Gary kept 234 marbles in 2 containers, A and B. After 40% of the marbles in Container A were transferred to Container B, there were 24 more marbles in Container A than Container B. How many marbles were there in Container B at first?

Part-Whole (Percentage + Additional Whole Number) Type 3

1. Irene spent 20% of her money and an additional \$3 on a story book. She then spent $\frac{2}{3}$ of the remaining money and an additional \$2 on a present. She had \$13 left. How much did Irene have at first?

 Dan spent 20% of his money and an additional \$4 on a CD. He then spent 1/3 of his remaining money and an additional \$8 on some comics. Given that he was left with \$24, how much money did he have at first?

Trending questions

1. During a sale, a shop offered a 20% discount on all its mobile phones.

Ming chose a phone which cost \$160 less than its usual price due to the discount given. He had to pay an additional 7% GST on the discounted price. How much did Ming pay for the mobile phone in the end? (MGS/SA2)

- 2. A florist sells bouquets of flowers at \$15 per bouquet. When a customer buys 3 or more bouquets, a discount of 5% will be given on the total bills.
 - a. Kelly bought 6 bouquets. How much was the discount given to her?
 - b. Mrs Ang paid \$ 513 after discount for some bouquets of flowers. How many bouquets of flowers did she buy?
