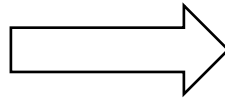

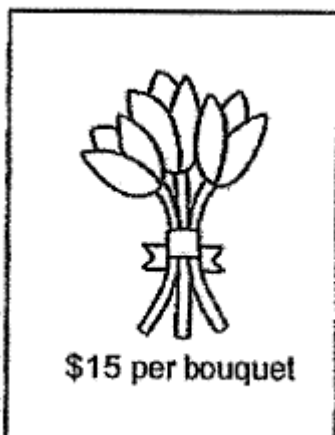
Trending questions

2. A florist sells bouquets of flowers at \$15 per bouquet. When a customer buys 3 or more bouquets, a discount of 5% will be given on the total bills.
 - a. Kelly bought 6 bouquets. How much was the discount given to her?
 - b. Mrs Ang paid \$ 513 after discount for some bouquets of flowers. How many bouquets of flowers did she buy?
